Just over a year ago, the Board of Directors approved Resolution #5 — to consider a suitable memorial for all NC State war casualties since the end of WWI. After many discussions, officials at NC State have decided to pursue this initiative. Recently, Doug Morton, Director of Facilities, met with our board President Larry Hancock to discuss recommendations for just such a memorial. As the initiative unfolds, details will be forthcoming. Our directors are very excited about the initiative.

At the end of this month, our active membership stands at 47, including three life and two honorary memberships. Albeit a small group of PR alumni, since last year when the company was reactivated, 2 graduates this year have joined our alumni association. We are growing slowly. The outlook for additional new alumni is promising in 2022. Our Board of Directors is excited by this development as well.

Our board approved Bylaw Number 6, Congleton-Etheridge Memorial Scholarship Fund, on October 14th. The Scholarship Committee reported that a recipient of the first scholarship will be announced next month.
