The L-4 Logo is a conglomerate of symbols. It was designed by David Lee, an Army ROTC cadet, and friend of the company. Congo, named for Major Roy Congleton, is the centerpiece. Congo's helmet symbolizes the warrior ethos that the ancient Greek Spartans lived by. Congo's teeth tightly grip the torch of knowledge ... meaning that P/Rs lead other students by its light. Crossed rifles denote the discipline created by drill and its ceremonies. Etched into the buttstock of each weapon are the dates that represent L-4's original charter (1953) date and its re-charter date (2020). L-4's motto, NO SLACK, is imbedded in the scroll. Its meaning exemplifies that P/Rs are the enforcers of a high standard. As such, they strive to exceed it, always.
