FACEBOOK MANAGER. Your help is always appreciated. Currently I am searching for someone to assume the duty of Facebook (FB) manager. What does this entail? L-4 REACTIVATION UPDATE. President Art Dumont reports the following:

- The National Society of Pershing Rifles reports that the L-4 charter issued in 1953 was never revoked when the company became "dark" over a decade ago. The conclusion is that the company's status is inactive till such time as it meets the requirements to reactive. Attempts to recover L-4 paraphernalia are on-going. Searches of the D. H. Hill Library's PR archive and the Department of Military Science have produced no significant results. The charter whereabouts remains a mystery.
- The L-4 Alumni Association Executive Committee has recently approved the president's request to search for a new off campus hard site in anticipation of an L-4 reactivation.
- Collaborating organizations with the L-4 Alumni Association include the NC State University Alumni Center and the General H. Hugh Shelton Leadership Center.
